## Confirmation Sponsor

The duties of Confirmation Sponsors are far from ceremonial.

The principal responsibility of a Sponsor is to give witness to the Catholic faith by his or her words and actions. As noted in the Code of Canon Law, "Insofar as possible, one to be baptized is to be given a sponsor who is to assist an adult in Christian initiation, or, together with the parents, to present an infant at the baptism, and who will help the baptized to lead a Christian life in harmony with baptism, and to fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it" (Canon 872).

In selecting sponsors, the Catholic Church requires:

- A sponsor cannot be a parent;
- A sponsor must be at least 16 years of age and have received the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and holy Communion;
- A sponsor must be living a life consistent with faith and morals as taught by the Catholic Church – this includes, faithful Mass attendance on Sundays and holy days of obligation;
- A sponsor must be a registered and active Catholic in their parish church
