Bishop Dear friends in Christ, we gather this evening to celebrate the Vigil Mass in honor of Our Lady's Assumption, your Patronal Feast Day. A year ago, on this Solemnity it was my joy to bring you the good news that Our Holy Father, Pope Francis had bestowed the title of Minor Basilica on your parish church. All this is granted, anything to the contrary notwithstanding.


