The St. Mark food pantry is staffed by 6-8 volunteers per day and is currently serving approximately 1200 families, through October 2023, which equates to about 3600 people. That number has grown from 695 families in 2014.

The food pantry is supplied with items from the Mid-Ohio Food Bank but is primarily supported through donations from the community. Items available to families include food, toiletries, and cleaning supplies.

**How you can become involved:**

**-Donate money**

Drop off your donation (cash or check) to the food pantry or drop it in the collection basket marked "Food Pantry."

**-Donate items**

Purchased items can be dropped off at the Food Pantry during hours of operation or can be left in the main entrance next to the adoration chapel at St. Mark any weekday. Purchasing items from Kroger? Use Kroger Community Rewards code (VW583) to support the Food Pantry even more!
