Instructions:

Children's Gifts

1. Select a gift tag and purchase items on tag. Please do **NOT** wrap the gifts although gift wrap is welcome with the gifts. Please place all gifts from a single tag in a bag just to keep the items together. If you have gift receipts, place them in an envelope with the gifts. Note: Gift receipts are kept by the case worker who is assigned to each child. If an exchange is needed because clothing does not fit, the case worker handles the exchange.

2. Return the gifts along with the gift tag **no later** than **Sunday, December 15**. Place the gifts either in the front entryway by the Christmas tree or in the south entrance by the Christmas tree.

Nursing Home Gifts

1. Select a gift tag and purchase the items on the tag. Please **WRAP** the gifts. Return the gifts to St Mary and place them in either the main vestibule or in the southern vestibule.

2. Return gifts, with the tags, **no later** than **Sunday, December 15**.

Senior Gift Tags

These gift tags are for a gift card from either Walmart or Meijer. It allows a Senior, who may need some extra groceries over the holidays, to purchase them or to get something they need but have trouble affording. Please place the gift cards in an envelope, along with the tag, and place the gift cards in the box provided in the main entryway.
